ACCESS ROUTES		
For Ambulance	Use vehicle access to Rotary playing pitches via Hill Barn Lane. Ambulance can then access both Rotary and Hill Barn pitches from this entrance. This entrance to pitches is in car park at south end of Hill Barn Lane – very near roundabout just 50yards north of A24/A27 roundabout) Someone should wait in Hill Barn Lane to direct ambulance into car park between houses. (NOTE: There is no ambulance access to pitches via northern end car park at top end of Hill Barn Lane as height barrier does not open)	
From Pitch to Ambulance	Use barrier keys in Hill Barn clubhouse kitchen to allow ambulance on to pitches. Same barrier key will open height restricted barrier as well as pitch access barrier. Every team manager has key to open Hill Barn	
	clubhouse kitchen as it is same key for main clubhouse door.

Worthing Utd Youth FC Pitches Address – Hill Barn Ln, Worthing, W Sussex, BN14 9QB



Ambulance entrance to all pitches is via the first car park entrance in Hill Barn Lane. Take this map to give to ambulance driver to show where incident is happening.

There are two yellow barriers (inc. one height barrier) to be opened to allow ambulance access to pitches. There is one key for both barriers. This key is located above the sink in the kitchen of the Hill Barn clubhouse.
