Covid information

As a football club we have produced our own risk assessment relating to covid-19 and good practice, your football club shall also have provided you with appropriate assessment and information. We would like to inform you of some rules and expectations when visiting Worthing Utd Youth this year.

You will have already received information regarding parking and pitch area for your team from our manager or secretary.

We shall:

- Clean and sanitise footballs before playing.
- Clean goalposts and corner flags at appropriate intervals.
 - Maintain social distancing.
 - Limit our spectators.
- Inform the opposition of any changes or specific matters.
- Not allow participants to shake hands ahead or after matches.
- Control and monitor our own parents and players from a track and trace perspective.
 - Adhere to government guidelines and rules.
 - Adhere to our risk assessment and any amendments made.
 - View opposition ID cards but shall not handle or touch them.
 - Advise on NHS QR codes.

We politely request:

- Visiting teams limit spectators in attendance.
- Please socially distance, we may need to ask your spectators to move to an allocated area, please respect any approach.
- We cannot guarantee the use of toilet facilities when on site, we will always try and facilitate requests but cannot guarantee this.
 - You and your teams adhere to government guidance.
 - You do not handle or touch ID cards but view them.
- You control and monitor your players and spectators from a track and trace perspective.
 - Use the NHS QR codes at clubhouses and other strategic points.
 - Inform your spectators & players.

Please respect local neighbours and businesses when attending the site and park in a responsible manner.

Please note the main car park is to the North via Hill Barn Lane in yellow (on plan), the car park on A27 is small and difficult to access and egress.



We do not have access to the Worthing college car park, if you park there it is at your own risk. Please note that the college car park usually will be locked closed from approximately 12:30pm.

Dogs are allowed on site but must be on a lead, there are dog waste bins adjacent the car parks.

Spectators must keep behind the RESPECT barrier and on the opposite side to the coaches and substitutes.

Please remove all litter when you depart and use the waste bins adjacent car parks.

Club houses are not for spectator use unless otherwise agreed, there are no public toilets on the site or available in the college.
